Each fall, we match Scholars who request mentors with adults who serve as a confidants and advisors. *Ideally, individuals will commit to mentor for the four years of their mentee's high school experience.*

School Liaisons

School Liaisons represent DMSF to Scholars in their school environments, meet with Scholars at least twice per academic year for day schools and once per year for boarding schools, provide partnership schools with a contact person in addition to DMSF staff, support the academic success of the Scholars, and encourage a sense of community amongst the Scholars.
